ORIGINAL

THIS MATTER came on before this Court for review pursuant to the Court's Order Setting Case Schedule, dated February 1, 2011. In connection with the review, William L. Beecher, Receiver for the above-captioned companies ("Receiver"), submitted Receiver's Supplemental Report and Request for Certain Case Administration Orders.

This Court has also heard and considered the records and files herein and the arguments of counsel, and is fully advised. Based on this Court's review and consideration, this Court has determined that Receiver's Request for Certain Case Administration Orders is well founded.

Based on the foregoing, it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that:

1 1. Receiver's Request for Certain Case Administration Orders is GRANTED in its
2 entirety.

3 2. With regard to creditor claims, this Court hereby approves the Proof of Claim
4 form attached hereto as Appendix 1. This Court orders that all claims must be served by
5 delivering or mailing the Proof of Claim form such that it is received by the Receiver or his
6 attorneys within 120 days from the date notice was given by mail or *August 1, 2011*, whichever
7 is later. Claims need not be filed with the Clerk of the Court

8 3. With regard to claims by state or federal agencies, this Court hereby approves the
9 Proof of Claim form attached hereto as Appendix 2. This Court further orders that all claims
10 filed by state or federal agencies must be filed not later than 180 days from the date notice was
11 given by mail or by *September 9, 2011*, whichever is later.

12 4. This Court reserves the right to establish additional Claims Bar Dates as the
13 interests of justice or the circumstances of the Receivership warrant.

14 5. The Court directs that notice of any request for compensation of professionals or
15 approval of settlement shall be mailed via U.S. First Class Mail, postage prepaid, to all parties
16 appearing on the Receiver's Master Mailing List and all active parties appearing in any adjunct
17 proceeding hereto pursuant to RCW 7.60.180 and RCW 7.60.190. The Notice shall include a
18 Response date for any objections, such date must be at least 27 days after the date Notice was
19 mailed. The Receiver or the party seeking professional compensation is directed to file copies of
20 the Notice and Declaration of Mailing with this Court and deliver Working Copies to
21 Judge Cuthbertson.

22 6. This Court finds that, in the event an objection is made to any request for
23 compensation of professionals or approval of settlement, this Court will resolve all objections on
24 Motion by the moving party, with 5 days notice to the objecting party only, and that such
25 Motion will be heard by this Court without oral argument.

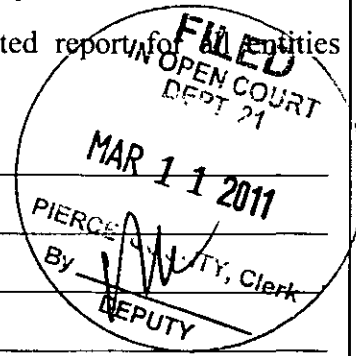
26 7. This Court finds that baring this Court's request for further information, in the
27 event no opposition to any request for compensation of professionals or approval of settlement is

1 received by the Response date, and upon the filing of a Declaration confirming that no
2 opposition has been received, the relief for which notice has been given shall be deemed
3 approved without action by this Court or further notice to creditors. Stipulated Orders of
4 Dismissal shall be submitted to and entered by this Court *ex parte*

5 8. This Court directs that the Receiver file his next report with this Court on
