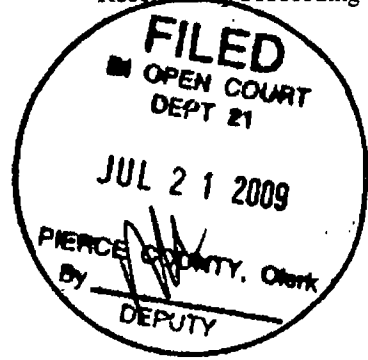

**CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER RE:
NOTICES, PROCEDURES, AND MATTERS INVOLVING ADMINISTRATION OF THE RECEIVERSHIP ESTATE**

This matter came on for presentation on an *ex parte* basis of the Motion of the Receiver, William L. Beecher, appearing through his attorneys, Smith Alling Lane, P.S., for an Order Approving Case Management Procedures. The Court, having considered the pleadings and comments of counsel, and being fully informed and advised, Orders as follows:

1. Extension of Time for Initial Notice Requirements.

The requirement to give Notice of the Pendency of the Receivership Case and establishment of a Claims Bar Date is hereby extended to November 13, 2009 or to such later date as may be ordered by the Court. The Court approves the form of Notice and Proof of Claim form as identified in the attached

1 Exhibit A. Upon reasonable identification of potential claimants, the Receiver shall cause to have the
2 Notice, Claims Bar Date, and Proof of Claim published in the Tacoma News Tribune and the Seattle
3 Times once a week for three consecutive weeks. Additionally, the Receiver shall send the required
4 Notice, Claims Bar Date, and Proof of Claim form to all known creditors and parties appearing in this
5 proceeding by regular first class mail. Nothing in this Order shall be deemed to preclude the Receiver
6 from seeking the entry of a second or later Claims Bar Date as the circumstances of the case and the
7 interests of justice require.

8 **2. Creation of a Master Mailing List and Website.**

9 The Receiver shall create and maintain a master mailing list as soon as practical, after creditors
10 and parties are identified, but not later than November 13, 2009, identifying all known creditors, creditors
11 who have filed claims, and parties who have appeared in this proceeding. The master list shall be
12 updated periodically and filed with the Clerk of the Court or otherwise made available for review by the
13 Court. The Receiver shall provide a copy of the list to those creditors and parties who request the list in
14 writing. The Receiver is authorized to incur and pay the reasonable costs of creating and maintaining a
15 Receivership Estate website to contain information regarding the administration of the Receivership
16 Estate, master mailing list, known creditors, claims filed, claim forms and notices, accountings, and
17 relevant Court documents that will aid creditors and parties in following and participating in the
18 administration and progress of the Receivership Estate .

19 **3. Limitation of Notices:** At the expiration of the Claims Bar Date or any extensions thereof, the
20 Receiver may limit further notices required of the statute or court order to be given only to those who
21 have filed claims or have otherwise appeared in the case and requested notice.

22 **4. Allowance and Disallowance of Claims:** The Receiver is authorized to allow filed claims that
23 agree with the books and records of the receivership estate, other sources, or are otherwise established to

1 the receiver's satisfaction without further court order. Objections to claims will be governed by the
2 procedures identified in RCW 7.60.220.

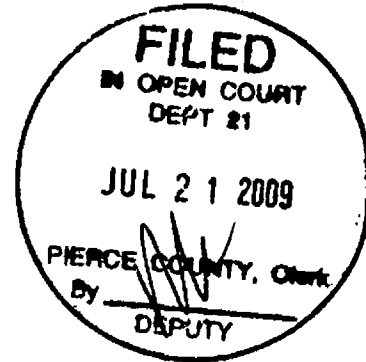

- 8 2. The Superior Court has established procedures for filing proofs of claims. Claims must be filed
 9 on the Proof of Claim form printed below. All claims, whether contingent, liquidated,
 10 unliquidated, or disputed, and claims that are secured with interests or liens against property of
 11 the Receivership Estate, arising prior to the appointment of the Receiver, must be served in
 accordance with this notice and RCW 7.60.210. Any claim not so filed is barred from
 participating in any distribution to creditors in the Receivership proceeding and may be deemed to
 have waived any further notice of proceedings.
- 12 3. Claims must be served by delivering or mailing the Proof of Claim form such that it is received
 13 by the Receiver or his attorneys within 120 days from the date notice is given by mail, or the date
 14 of first publication of this notice, whichever is later. Claims need not be filed with the Clerk of
 the Court. Claims filed by state or federal agencies must be filed not later than 180 days from the
 15 later date of mailing or the first publication of this notice. The Superior Court has reserved the
 right to establish additional claims bar dates as the interests of justice or the circumstances of the
 case warrant.
- 16 4. Claims must be in writing and provide the information required by the Proof of Claim form
 17 printed below. At a minimum, the claim must identify the name and address of the creditor(s),
 18 the nature and amount of the claim, and the date of the claim, and be executed by the claimant or
 19 authorized representative of the claimant. When a claim, or a security interest in property of the
 Receivership Estate, is based on a writing, the original or a copy of the original writing must be
 included as part of the proof of claim, together with evidence of perfection of any security interest
 or other lien asserted by the claimant. A claim, executed and served in accordance with this
 notice, constitutes *prima facie* evidence of the validity and amount of the claim.
